The construction of the Henry Kendall Memorial Fountain at Milton School was completed, the construction of the Rotary Lookout at Pointers Gap, the holding of a number of Fireside Meetings focusing particularly on Rotary Information for the new members, the erection of a Plaque in Brodie Park, 90 cents per meal, the charge for a Christmas Ladies Night was \$2.00 per person and a Door Knock Appeal for the Crippled Children raised \$278. Sid Turnbull was inducted.
