## Membership increases during 2008-09 Rotary year

In a year of economic havoc that rocked global markets and shook consumer confidence, Rotary International's most important asset – its members – steadily grew.

As of 30 June, the end of the 2008-09 RI year, there were 1,234,527 members in 33,790 Rotary clubs. That's an increase of 3,044 members and 520 clubs from the previous year.

"New clubs are forming in communities with existing clubs by offering alternative times and the opportunity to bring fresh perspectives to Rotary," said Mike McGovern, chair of RI's Membership Development and Retention Committee.

"We must reach out to people who are different from us and from the members in our club, because this is the way to a stronger club with more connections and better potential," RI PP Lee said at the 2009 International Assembly in San Diego, California, USA.
