HAITI; Rotary's ShelterBoxes



Four year-old Carlos had his leg amputated. He is now recovering in a ShelterBox tent and is pictured using one of the children's packs sent in the Boxes.

ShelterBox tents are providing emergency shelter in and around Port au Prince and hundreds more ShelterBoxes arrived on Friday (last week), As soon as the tents are up at the hospitals there are patients moving into them. ShelterBox is prioritising women and children providing tents, blankets, water containers, kitchenware and children's packs.

In hospitals, orphanages and local communities ShelterBox is making a difference.
