The Club welcomed PDG Bob Greeney who gave us an update on the upcoming Rotary Conference in Canberra. Bob highlighted the cost as being only \$100 which included morning teas, lunch on both Sat & Sun, and the dinner on Saturday Evening. However if your spouse decided to come to the dinner it would add a further \$ 45.

Bob, being the District representative to the Council of Legislation and outlined that despite the best determination of the Australian mission only a small number of the resolutions got up. Bob mentioned that the strong US delegation does influence the decisions.

Some other decisions;

1. Permit 2 X E clubs per district
2. Magazine subs can now be amortised to 1 per couple where both partners are in Rotary.
3. 5th Ave of Service created that of “New Generation”
4. Multi District President Elect training Seminars
5. RI per capita dues increased to \$ 25 per ½ year.
6. Satellite club now permitted.
7. Boundaries of Districts to be adjusted when there are less than 33 clubs or 1500 members.
