As of 1 Aug 2010, Rotarians have raised about \$141.2 million for Rotary's US\$200 Million Challenge. These contributions will help Rotary raise \$200 million to match \$355 million in challenge grants received from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.

**RI President Ray Klingensmith** of the Rotary Club of Kirksville, Missouri, USA, a Rotarian since 1961, Klingensmith has served Rotary as district governor and as chair of the 1998 Council on Legislation in New Delhi and the 2008 Los Angeles Convention Committee. He was a member of the RI Board of Directors for 1985-87 and chaired its executive committee in 1986-87. Klingensmith joined The Rotary Foundation Trustees in 2002, serving as vice chair in 2005-06, and was a member of the Future Vision Committee from 2005 to 2008.

Klingensmith earned degrees in business and law at the University of Missouri and completed graduate studies at the University of Cape Town, South Africa, as a Rotary Foundation Ambassadorial Scholar.

Ray, now operates a law office, he and his wife, Judie, have two children and three grandchildren.
