PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Rotarians, partners and friends,

This year has seen the club work hard in the local community as well as internationally. Issa Shalhoub and Dom Fondacaro made our Clubs 50th Anniversary an important event for us all. Thanks for making it happen.

Through Carolyn Campbell's efforts on the International front we have been very supportive in trying to eradicate Polio from our world. We are close, with only a few countries remaining to eradicate this disease. Our club continues to support villages in the Pacific with Malaria protection, individuals in Bangladesh with Cleft Palate operations, Vision Care in Peru, Children's Health and more recently in the purchases on a large number of shelter boxes to support people who have suffered through natural disasters – bush fires, earthquakes and tsunamis. This year over \$11,000 was given to these projects. Youth exchanges have continued and regularly we host Group Study Exchanges (the most recent one being from China) or Friendship visits from overseas.

Locally, we continue with working bees, BBQs at Milton Show, support of Mallala, Davenport and Budawang, Rescue Helicopter Services, Coastal Patrol, hospital needs (especially cancer support), community organisations, The Entertainers, RYPEN and RYLA and led the community in bringing back The Blessing of the Fleet. Local students benefit from our involvement in camps, the Life Education Van, exposure to the Sciences and Leadership courses. We have expended over \$25,000 on these projects. The efforts of Dale Wilford and Denise Fors are to be commended.

We have continued with fund raising through the Jumping Castle, Business Awards, Calcutta, Swap Meet and The Entertainers. The work of Craig Saunders, Rob Powell, Keith Bennett and Bob Lawson (and the rest of the club) has ensured that funds raised and spent for charity (nearly \$40,000 worth of donations) have been quite successful this year.

The Rotary Club has continued to lead in the community with the continuance of The Blessing of the Fleet. Phil Brown has strived very hard to make The Blessing of the Fleet one of Ulladulla's premium tourist events. Well done Phil.

This is what has made us a successful club – friendship and camaraderie at these events. All members have contributed in a variety of ways this year, cleaning of BBQs, running the Jumping Castle and spending a large amount of time behind numerous bar service events that included picking up and cleaning glasses. Over 30,000 hours of your time has helped make all these events successful.

Our club continues to build goodwill and better friendships and as more and more people work with us (ROTARY) then everyone benefits. This was evidenced by Stuart Carless broadening our horizons with very interesting speakers at our dinner meetings and Joe Puglisi, whose secretarial skills were second to none. There are too many individuals in the club to name them here, so I would like to congratulate everyone who has contributed their time and effort, especially those who accepted and undertook leadership responsibilities – to make things happen. Thank you all for your support.

INTERNATIONAL REPORT

Another year has passed, neighbours in the International community have been challenged and pushed to their limits with ongoing natural disasters. Whilst we are one Rotary Club amongst many all over the world, your Milton-Ulladulla Rotary Club has made a difference in helping those less fortunate.

Our club has continued to support the Shelter Box program; Shelter boxes have assisted those in need, sheltering families and providing the basic needs for survival. The boxes provide Dry shelter, warm beds, clean water and cooking facilities. Shelter Box Australia in conjunction with affiliates around the world; have deployed boxes to the Philippines, Taiwan, China, whose homes were destroyed by Typhoon Morakot. The boxes assisted the people of Haiti, in January a devastated Port a Prince hit by an earthquake, this list goes on, but we are making a difference. This year our club displayed the Shelter boxes at the Milton Show and Blessing of the Fleet, helping our community understand their importance. Funding a total of 6 boxes at \$1,200 each = \$7,200.00.

A new project this year for our club was to host the Chinese GSE team (Group Study Exchange). The team was hosted by our club 7- 9 November. Bill Crampton –Team Leader a senior executive in the area of training and education. Carol Chen, Account Manager, in a relocation service that helps expats relocate inbound and outbound within China. Coco Wang, Project Director at the Sunrise Library Foundation. A charity focusing on building libraries for kids in poor and undeveloped areas of China. Eric Liu, Relationship Manager Consumer Group at Citibank and Lily Liu, Head of the Legal Department at the German Centre for Industry and Trade in Shanghai. Members of our club had the opportunity to mingle, learn a different culture and enjoy the company of the GSE team. The GSE team enjoyed a Barbeque at Rotary Park meeting friends and families of Rotary. A walk to Mt Bushwalker, our beautiful Budawang mountains. Finally ending their stay with us, at a luncheon with the dolphins at the Mollymook Golf Club.

Our club continues to support other projects such as Rotarians Against Malaria and the eradication of Polio.

RAM (Rotarians Against Malaria) is an initiative to help prevent and eradicate Malaria, by the distribution of Insecticide Treated Mosquito Nets and the education of all ages to help prevent the spread of the disease. -\$1,000.

Rotary International and its partners over 20 years are close to eradicating polio. Polio continues to infect and paralyse children, robbing them of their futures and compounding the hardships faced by their families - \$1,000.

We also care about those who have little or no sight in supporting a team of Eye specialists travelling to Peru, making a difference. Our club has donated \$1,000.

As your International Director for this year I would like to thank all members, families and friends of Rotary, who supported these programs, with your continued support we can make a difference.
