Shoalhaven Council Waste Management services Manager

Evelyn gave the Club an inspired address on the benefits of waste management. Covering everything from rubbish pickup at the kerb, to Magical Mystery Tours! Her enthusiasm for things we consider trash is infectious and she demonstrated the benefits of disposing of “things” correctly.

Something that most of us were unaware of was the use of the Free Tipping vouchers> She highlighted that these could be used for the removal of Bulky waste, and Garden organics waste. The tipping vouchers allow you to dispose 1 cubic metre of waste for free of either waste.

Just call 4421 5786 and Council will come to you to collect.

Evelyn also emphasised that the Shoalhaven Home Compost Program would again be run by Council, All you need to do is to attend a lesson for 90 minutes and for your trouble you will receive a Free Kitchen tidy bin for your scraps. These will be run in Ulladulla, Nowra and Huskisson. Evelyn gave some statistics which are quite impressive;

1. Council processed 15000 tonnes of Green waste after the last major Storm we had late year
2. Collected 1200 TV weighing 55 tonnes in last clean up
3. Waste vehicles will be colour coded under the new contract just let. Green for the everyday waste, Yellow for Recycle waste.
4. Costs Council \$ 800,000 to process 500 tonnes of waste.
