The Ulladulla Respite Service conducts groups for older people and people living with memory loss who are living at home with a carer or at home with a carer visiting regularly.

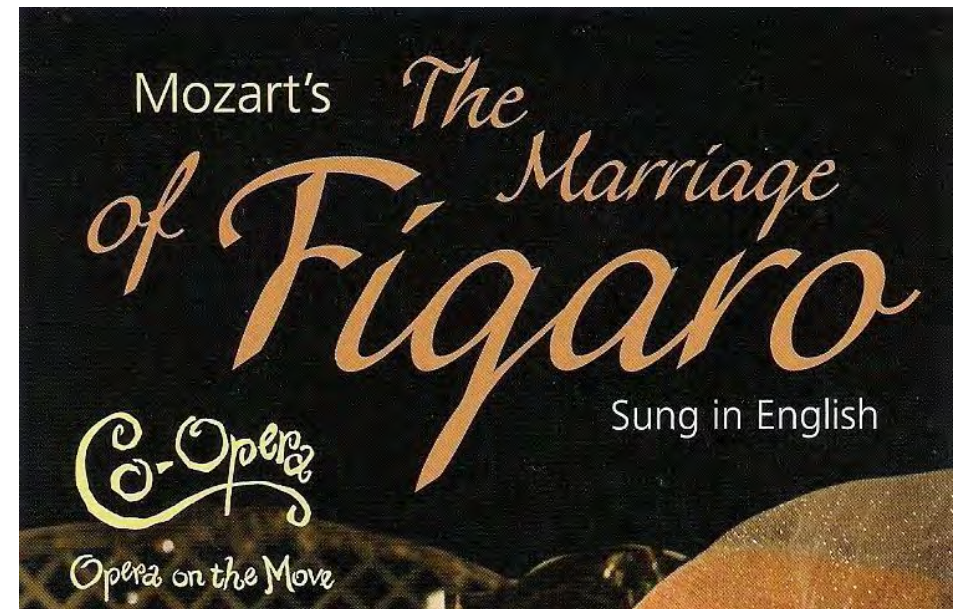
Yvonne mentioned that referrals can be made by anyone, including self, family, friend, doctor, or other service providers and health professionals.

Eligibility is based on an assessment of individual needs and circumstances. Service provision ceases upon permanent admission in hostel or nursing home care.

Group Programmes are planned and facilitated by qualified staff with the assistance of volunteer workers; Programmes include Games, guest speakers, drama, story writing, quizzes, craft, singalongs and outings. Activities are designed to be stimulating and enjoyable and to meet the special needs or participants. Groups are held in a safe and friendly and supportive environment.
