Dick Crouch called for helpers for the BOF Ball.

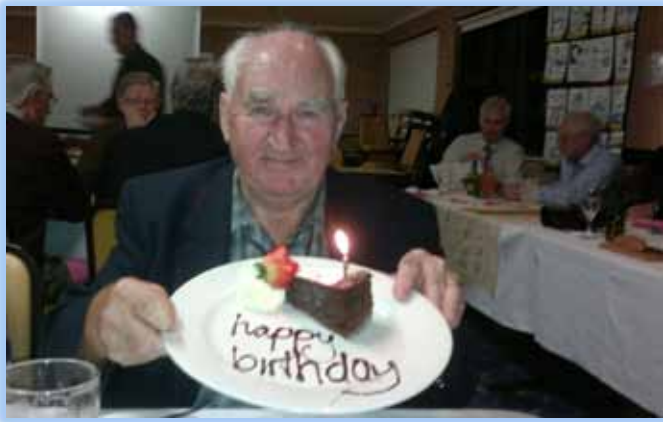
Phil Brown asked for the help of all members with the BOF, the SCC is offering our members a free Traffic Control Training, more info to follow.
