Rob also said that Rotary is Service based rather than Attendance based, he spoke on Member recruitment and retention, Polio in numbers and he Thanked Werner Pohl for his years of service, the ADG, Geoff Muir for his District's work and Issa for his work for Zone 8 and Zone 7B with the Rotary on the Move Newsletter.

**Beth Woolley** spoke on the Children Medical Emergency Fund, for children with medical emergencies or crisis, Quilt making and the Indigenous Scholarship in Midwifery.



**Saturday 10 Sept**, the Yellow Boats arrived in Ulladulla Harbour at 3pm, the boats were escorted into the Harbour by two rescue boats (with Rotarians on board) and the crew were greeted by quite a few Rotarians on the wharf.

- In the evening 12 members and 8 partners had a meal with the crew and Rob's children, then Rob gave us a summary of his journey.

- They left Sydney on the 31<sup>st</sup> of May 2011, and circumnavigated anticlockwise around Australia to raise money for Polio.
