Last Week's Meeting Reports:

Although fewer in numbers the meeting proved a very productive and informative one. President Dale set the scene by reminding members that it was a chance to review the previous six months and plan for the next six months.

Meeting opened by **President Dale** with an International Toast to the nation of Lithuania.

Dom Fondacaro reminded us about the special thank you prawns and pizza luncheon to be held Easter Monday for the hardworking Rotary members.

Bob Lawson sought volunteers for the upcoming Jumping Castle commitment at the Ulladulla Preschool.

Sub Committee Reports:

1. YOUTH Programs achieved include RYLA, PYPEN, Science School and National Science School plans. Other ideas include a School Captains evening; a public speaking opportunity for school students. The Blessing of the Fleet now includes 45 princesses with plans for the ball to take place on 24 March at the local Civic Centre at \$70 per head.

2. VOCATIONAL: Programs include the March Rotary Award of Excellence; the Vocational Service Award; the Ulladulla Leisure Centre program; the award for the most improved student at Ulladulla Public School and the important Business awards Night.

3. COMMUNITY SERVICE: Programs include; Bowel Scan (kits to be provided to pharmacies on 23 February,); CBD bike racks for Wason St precinct; Clean up Australia program to be emailed for 2,3 March; Seniors Week program 16 – 25 March; ongoing developments at Rotary Park; Tim and John were thanked for their excellent support of the Christmas Tree programme.

4. INTERNATIONAL Eve reminded us that the plan is to spend 50% on international projects and reserve 50% for disaster relief programs;

Specialist Programs include:

Sustainable Cambodia with the distribution of nutritious foodpacks to preschoolers (This has been linked with a club in Western Australia with matching grant from District)

Eyes for Africa with \$1000 being seeded for cataract replacement program in parts of Africa.

RAMS with \$1000 dedicated to the eradication of malaria from villages in PNG;

Money Box program for polio eradication with special thanks to Clive for developing this project;

Shelter Box program with \$2000 being dedicated to the provision of two boxes per annum to be used on a discretionary basis.

Interact club development to be discussed with Sussex Inlet Club for reestablishment at Shoalhaven Anglican School.

President Dale reminded members to bring a friend to evenings when good speakers would be on offering. New members are always a sign of a growing , healthy club.

Recommendations were made to approach the Bowling Club to improve the PA system especially in the light of OHS issues;

An Appreciation Award to Garden Haven and Luke T. has been mooted for assistance with Christmas Tree project.

HarbourFest will be reviewed at a later meeting.

Dick won the Card raffle with 86 but no cards.
