Guest Speakers last week included Barrie Wilford and John Vine who gave us a good presentation on the history and success of the Mens Shed initiative in the local district. After three years of operation the shed attracts over 70 members with 20 being regular. The Shed serves many different social needs for men and is experimenting with a wider set of programmes.

John Vine continued the theme with the suggestion that Rotary support the idea of setting up training programmes to teach younger people the values and methods of contributing to community organisations and volunteering to participate on managing committees.

Rotarians are urged to continue taking advantage of the moneybox scheme as over 5,000 boxes have been utilized so far. The money box project is now on youtube and will feature at the forthcoming conference at Bangkok.
