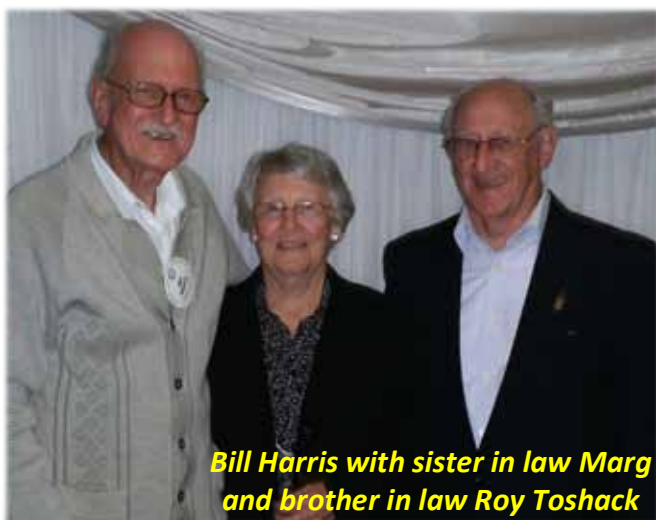
**Card Raffle** winner; Issa Shalhoub **♦** (no Arnold, phew!)
