## Driver Education and Behaviour Program

Our Club has been involved with this program since 1991, when Robin Cantrill was President, with the help of the then Senior Constable Ken McDonald. Recently the program has been running with the help and organisation of President Michael Mastronardi.

This year in total over 100 students, currently in year 11, participated in the Driver Education and Behaviour program from both Ulladulla High School and Shoalhaven Anglican School.

Three groups of students participated in late October and early November, each group spent a day at the Ex-Servos Club and then travelled to Marulan Driving Training Centre, near Goulburn.

All students attending were given education on driver safety, road education and were either the driver and or passenger in vehicles at Marulan Driving Track. The students at Marulan Driving Training Centre were given a chance to drive old vehicles courtesy of Marulan Driving Training Centre and new vehicles courtesy of Alan May Holden Ulladulla. Students were taken through the skid pan and braking exercises.

At the Milton-Ulladulla Ex-Servos' Club the day before attending the driving track at Marulan the students were taken through their paces of car safety, scenes of accidents, car mechanic and what to do if they come across a scene of an accident.
