Bill Fraser, a publicity and promotion volunteer with the Royal Flying Doctor Service (RFDS), spoke on this valuable organisation, its history and accomplishments. The service provides Air Ambulance Services, sets up regular clinics in country towns and performs aero-medical evacuations. It also provides a 24 hour GP phone-radio consultation service, supplies medical chests to isolated stations which can be used when needed after consulting with a phone-in GP. RFDS is for everyone, the service is needed not only by people living in the outback but also by tourists, miners, interstate truck drivers and road accident victims.

Last year the RFDS helped over 275,000 patients and flew the equivalent of 35 round trips to the moon. RFDS relies on public donations for 40% of its budget, please visit their website: www.flyingdoctor.net
