Guest Speaker; Katrina Walsh a speech therapist in private practice, has a long association with Rotary through her father at the Rotary Club of Grenfell, Katrina has a degree Occupational Therapy and mainly deals with children and stroke victims. Katrina and her family are very involved in surf lifesaving.

Katrina carried out some very interesting experiments with Rotarians to illustrate the difficulty in swallowing food when people have had a stroke which includes the loss of the use of their lips and tongue.

A response to this is for inexperienced people to want to tilt the stroke victim's head and the food in a liquid form tends to go down the windpipe and cause choking and perhaps pneumonia.



Stroke victims and those who may have Parkinson's disease often find difficulty in swallowing because their food may not be hydrated sufficiently.

Rotarians on the night found Katrina's talk and experiments to be a very interesting learning experience.

Karina is in private practise and also works with children who have speech impediments and have difficulty with word sounds.
