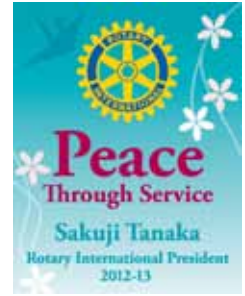

Guest Speaker Paula Smith is very committed to working with the Mercy Ships charity. The Mercy Ship is a floating hospital run by the Global Christian Charity, 'Bringing Hope and Healing to Those Who Have None' is their motto. It is the largest non-government funded hospital. The ship visits areas of extreme poverty mainly in West Africa.

After being invited to work in the area by the government of the country the ship operates from that port for up to ten months. The ship goes to Teneriffe in Queensland for maintenance.

The Mercy Ship has a capacity to have 7000 surgery per year in the 6 operating theatres. There are 400 volunteers, of 35 different nationalities, including engineers, medical and maintenance people.

The captain is a volunteer and enforces the rules concerning safety and well-being of the ship's company. Operations are carried out on facial tumours, cleft palates, crippled people, blind people and vaginal fistulas. Some 11,300 dental procedures are also carried out each year.

Off ship projects also include agricultural advice, nutritional clinics, micro business organization, control of malaria, water development projects and the building of schools.

Funds are being raised for a second ship. Paula has had two invitations to work on the ship; Liberia in 2007 and Togo in 2010. Paula reminded the Club that the Mercy Ship is also a little known Rotary project.
