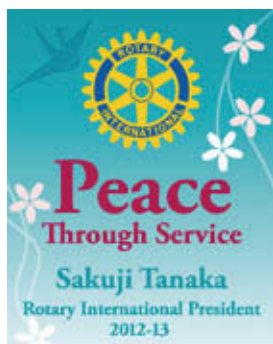

## INTERNATIONAL REPORT

I submit the International Director report on behalf of Eve Bosak for the 2012-13 year, for health reasons Eve was unable take the responsibility on, but Eve has given me great advice & encouragement throughout the year. We have achieved the goals set out in the program I submitted last May-June.

We continued with our weekly International National & Independence days toasts & I think our membership like it. I recommend the 2013-14 board to continue with this.

As to the Polio Project; we have done pretty well so far. The main point is that we have no debt & we almost own the stock we store at 'Lynns Removals', thanks to Peter Hughes. We started off with 5,200 & have approx. 4,200 left. We have contributed \$1,400 to the Polio fund. The remaining 4,200 moneyboxes have the potential to raise around \$42,000 for the polio fund. Our club will have "caused" that to happen.

We ran into trouble this year as some clubs in our District believed we were out to profiteer from them with our moneyboxes. That of course was never ever the case. Our project looks to facilitate fundraising by district clubs and not to profiteer from clubs.

Our approach now is to offer clubs 50 moneyboxes for free plus postage-delivery with an option to pay our cost of \$2 each. I am working on putting a proposal to DG Elect Maureen Manning for us to send district clubs 50 moneyboxes together with an invoice for the postage-delivery only. Included in the package will be some suggestions on how to use them for fundraising.

We have had great support outside our district with 3 other districts taking our project on. I know that one event alone at a Norfolk Island D9910 Conference collected over \$900.00 & most clubs in that district (Norfolk, NZ, Pacific Islands) have been sent a number of moneyboxes for on selling & coin collection. Also, 200 moneyboxes have been distributed to clubs in D9750 including Timor Este, Cairns, and Townsville etc.

We now have great Federal Politician support-endorsement including from Opposition Leader Tony Abbott. The PM Julia Gillard has a couple of our moneyboxes & has passed on a package from us to Mr. Bill Gates, which includes 10 moneyboxes & a letter from us.

I do have a little hope that we may hear from Mr. Gates. We have had great support from our MP Joanna Gash & Liberal candidate Ann Sudmalis. These two great ladies facilitated our federal politician contacts.

I have had great support within our club, President Michael, Issa Shalhoub, Jeni & Brian Wilkins, Carol & Peter Campbell, Robin Cantrill, Wayne Fry, Glenn Rowen, Dale Wilford, Peter Culham, Trevor Schofield & the club in general. Issa & I have been updating our Fact Sheet, Fact Poster & videos on the Club's website & will relaunch the project this July.

I assume to continue with the project, as I have since its launch in Oct 2011 and I am happy to do so.

## NEW GENERATIONS REPORT

It has been an interesting time for the New Generations committee. The budget was set at \$10,430.00 the budget was set quite high as the committee factored in 8 students going to the Rotary Youth Program of Enrichment (RYPEN), 2 Students attending Honeywell, 2 students attending National Science Youth Forum (NSYF), Year 9 students attending Outward Bound. The amount spent by the New Generations was \$4,215.00 on RYPEN, Outward Bound and Honey well Engineering Summer School.

Money was also set aside for programs that Milton Ulladulla Rotary Club have assisted with in previous years these programs were Study day at Bega for Year 11 students, SKIDS and RYE. These monies at this present time hadn't been requested though the money will be in the 2013-2014 budget for youth.

RYPEN 2012-13 Five students attended September 2012 and Three students attended May 2013 attended total cost was \$2320.00 in sending eight students from both Ulladulla High School and Shoalhaven Anglican School. Outward Bound \$1200.00 was allocated and sponsored for the Year 9 students from Ulladulla High School, Outward Bound assists students in gaining skills for life.

For achievements for the Youth/New Generations in the 2012-13 are as follows;

- Sending 8 students to 2 RYPEN camps and attending Rotary to share their experience.
- School captains from both schools speaking at Rotary on goals and achievements
- Student applying to attend the NSYF though later withdrawing.
- Joseph Meehan attending Honeywell in December and speaking at Rotary on attending Honeywell engineering summer school. Joseph attendance was fully sponsored by the Milton Ulladulla Rotary Club cost \$695.00.
- Outward bound students attending Rotary to share their experience on attending Outward Bound.

Future Projects/Goals for New Generations

- RYLA – looking at sending a young leader from the area to attend RYLA this year
- Honeywell Engineering Summer School and National Science Youth Forum
- Schools captains to continue to attend Rotary in the month of September
- Young achievers in the area to guest speak at Rotary in September for New Generations month
- Exchange students looking at hosting in future years.
- Sponsorship for presentation day at the local schools

Members of the New Generations also assisted in the Driver Education programme held in November 2012, looking at this support continuing in future years.

Though these above projects would not happen without the assistance of the Rotary Club and their ongoing fundraising efforts in the community through the clubs various fundraising projects. A huge thank to the members for their efforts in fundraising.

## TREASURER'S REPORT

Our club has had a very busy and successful year, our thoughts are with our longstanding treasurer Keith Bennett who retired due to ill health, and our treasurer's role was taken over mid-year by Kevin Walsh who recently relocated to a new town to broaden his work opportunities.

The Milton Ulladulla Rotary club has turned over in revenue approximately \$300,000.00; this is down on 2012 by 9.09%. There are a couple of reasons why revenue is down:

- 1 The Entertainers Bar was not a Rotary project this year due to the Civic Centre being unavailable.
