**Raffle Winner;** Yvonne Young J ♠.

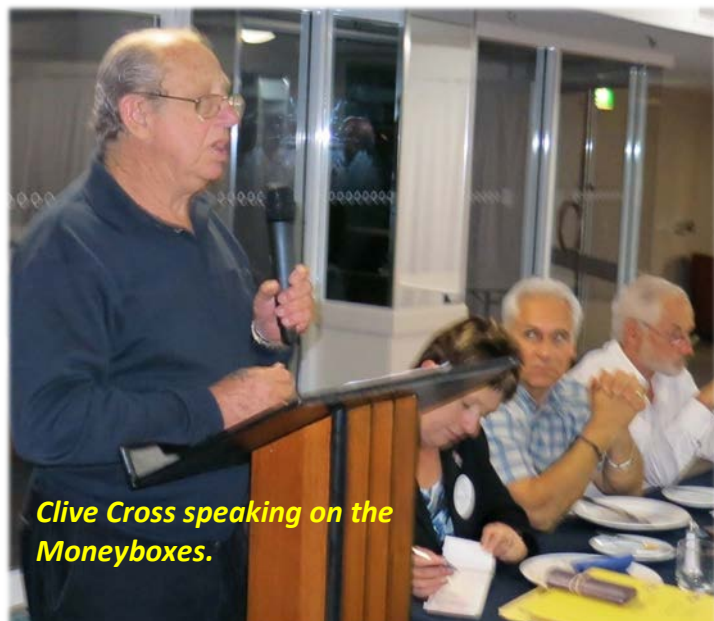
**Attendance** as per Peter Campbell: **71.69%**.
