**Craig Cameron** said that our Club will be shipping immediately two ShelterBoxes to the Philippines. Disaster Aid is raffling a van, \$5 a ticket and only 3,000 tickets will be sold.

**Guest Speaker Scott Corson** has the sea in his blood as he has experience in prawn trawling in northern Queensland. Scott is now a contractor to the Australian navy. He is working on radio controlled boats that tow targets, sonar detectors and torpedoes at Jervis Bay and in Western Australia. He also works with groups such as Geoscientists mapping the sea floor, testing sediments and water quality.



Scott showed slides of various types of sonar buoys and guided drone aeroplanes. A very interesting sonar device, using solar panels and by means of wave driven paddles, was able to propel its self from Los Angeles to Sydney. One interesting device is use to detect if submarines that have undergone refits, are generating more noise than before. The new torpedo can not only detect a target but they are also able to seek out a more vulnerable area of the target before destroying it.
