The Guest Speaker was our member Grant Schultz; Grant moved to our area in 2009, he has been with the Australian Federal Police for twenty eight years, and now is the licensee of Coast Real Estate in Milton. Grant spoke of his involvement with East Timor, he was first involved in 2001 through the United Nations. Grant gave a brief history of that country which is situated north of Australia, has a similar climate to Darwin and was ruled by the Portuguese then Indonesia till they had their independence in 1999.

Grant returned to East Timor in 2004 and again in 2006. Grant was involved with training of the East Timor police and riot control and he said that the Australian Federal Police worked alongside to the Australian Defence Force. Grant described the locals as peaceful and said that they showed a lot of respect to Australians, he enjoyed his time there with good accommodation and friendly people. East Timor is rich in oil and gas fields which will bring in money that will lead to great improvement in the country.
