**STEAM ENGINE HISTORY**

**1974-75 P CLIVE JOHNSTON** The Milton Ulladulla RC has achieved their desired result in retaining Mitchel’s Steam Engine. The Engine is placed on bearers, cleaned, greased and painted to prevent corrosion.

**1970-80 P CLAUDE BROWN** The Steam Engine was moved to the depot of Shoalhaven City Council, with possible installation in tourist area.

**1983-84 P JACK SCHARKIE** The Steam Engine Project became a reality through Ted Walker’s effort.

**1984-85 P DOUG JAMES** The Steam Engine Project became a little closer to reality with the actual Engine sitting on its new foundation.

**1986-87 P KEN MATTHEWS** 1987 was the year we completed one of our ongoing projects, the Mitchel’s Mill Steam Engine. The project initiated by Past President Ted Walker, has not only involved our own fellow Rotarians but many people outside of Rotary such as the City Council, 2ST Mr Trevor Jackson for taping our Historical Tape, Mr Brian Beake electrical installation, Mr Kevin Pollock donation of reduction gearbox, Mrs Margaret Pollock for her typing the history of the Engine and Mr Ron Knight for the donation of crane sandblasting and installation of the Steam Engine at Civic Centre.

**1987-88 P KEVIN DESREAUX** The sound track for the Steam Engine was completed.

**1990-91 P GREG PARNHAM** The Steam Engine received a face-lift.

**2001-02 P WAYNE FRY** Painting at the Steam Engine complex by Margaret and Werner Pohl.

**2005-06 P KEITH BENNETT** We worked on the fence of the old steam engine at the Civic Centre.
