Guest Speaker PP Ross Ellis; 'ROTARY E-CLUB OF BRINDABELLA'

Ross from the Rotary E-Club of Brindabella spent some forty one years in the Infantry before his retirement. Ross has been in the Canberra area as a Rotarian for 23 years.



Ross became interested in forming a Rotary E-Club, after the demise of Rotary Club of Canberra Fyshwick, for those members who could not fulfil their service to others or attendance requirements due to distance, meeting time or mobility. The idea of an Internet Club was started in Colorado, USA.

He gave an example of one member who works on an oil rig in New Guinea. Another who lives, works in Darwin and does her Rotary Service in community service in Darwin, other members use other community service work to fulfil their obligations.

A website and through the use of Dropbox members can be given agendas. The website and the use of Facebook enables members to be contacted and informed about Guests speakers and service carried out. It also enables visitors to contact the club for make-ups.

A possible problem could be distance and access to internet outlets and how they can help members to be financial so that the club can meet its obligations with Rotary International. It is easy to see how members can remain in contact with each other through their interest in Rotary. E-Club Members get together quarterly.

It appears that an E Club could help other service clubs to form and be in contact with members who have a problem with distance and mobility through injury or work requirements.
