Entering numerous competitions with the Australian Mathematics Trust and the University of NSW, Tim has enjoyed much success. In fact he came equal first in Australia in the National Science Competition. Combining his love of science, physics and design, Tim has recently constructed a wind tunnel and a wave tank. With hopes to get involved with aviation, Tim thanked Rotary for the opportunity to participate in the upcoming School Science Experience.
