Guest Speakers David Robertson and Jake Adlam, NYSF students who are no strangers to Rotary, after speaking before the club on other occasions, Jake, from SAS and David, an UHS student, further impressed attendees on their achievements. Fifty seven students applied for the NYSF, thirty seven of these were granted interviews and fifteen were from the Shoalhaven region. David spoke of the interview process, outlining the range of activities undertaken. Students were split into three groups and participated in group discussions on scientific topics and engaged in team work problem solving. During the final interview, students were met by a Rotarian, a Scientist and a former NYSF student. David enjoyed being around like-minded people from all over the country. Jake Adlam spoke of his initial nervousness and how he dealt with the six questions he had to answer as part of the process. He was pleased to see David Robertson again as well as friends from Nowra. Jake was very impressed with the quick response, with an email advising him of his success. Both students were extremely happy to be chosen to participate in the National Youth Science Forum and thanked our Club for the generous contribution of two thousand dollars for each student to attend the Forum.
