Guest Speaker Carolyn McDermott spoke of her work with the Ulladulla Soup Kitchen Inc., run jointly with the Bateman's Bay Soup Kitchen.

Carolyn lost her house in a fire three years ago and became homeless and it was her fourteen year old daughter who told her that now she knew how homeless people felt.

This was the start of their project because they both realised that there are many people in the Ulladulla district who had nowhere to sleep at night, possibly no meal and no company to enjoy.

Carolyn had commenced a charity through a caravan to supply at least one meal a week to approximately 15 to 39 people in Ulladulla. With her years of experience Carolyn can prepare a healthy meal for thirty people at a cost of \$30.

Carolyn also provides a packed lunch for school children in need. She feels strongly that education for children may help break the cycle of poverty.



Homeless affects three main groups of people; single people under 25 years, under 40 years and over 50 years.

Carolyn's unselfish work helps people to obtain a meal, personal care products, toiletries, swags for sleeping and material for protection from cold and wet weather and also offers support, love and reassurance.

Carolyn relies on donations as well as spending her own money to finance this work. Swags have been donated anonymously by a local plumber. Carolyn said that it is not a crime for homeless people to seek help within a community.

Carolyn would like to extend her work to more days a week, currently in Ulladulla it is only once a week that the Soup Kitchen offers a two course meal for the needy.
