DG Official Combined (Milton-Ulladulla and Sussex Inlet) Clubs visit and Hat Day:

DG Rowley Tompsett, during his visits to clubs in his District noted that Rotarians were inspired and carried out Rotary projects with a passion He spoke of one plus one, when two clubs with the same ideals, work together in a community combine and maximize results by having a greater pool of workers.

Rowley reminded clubs that the project Polio Plus to eradicate Polio worldwide was commenced in Australia in 1979. With the combined effort of United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), World Health Organization (WHO), 34,000 Rotary Clubs worldwide and the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation has almost rid the world of Polio. The Rotary Club of Milton-Ulladulla has been very effective in bringing the idea of Polio Money Boxes to Rotary through District Clubs and to overseas Clubs.

Rowley told the Clubs that Our Youth - Our Future is the theme for the Rotary Conference in Canberra in November. There are many young people including Rotary Exchange students, Rotaract RYLA and RYPEN students who could be involved in Rotary projects. Rowley suggested we ask young people who have been involved with our Club if they would like to attend the Conference.

Denise Tompsett will run with the traditional District Governor's Partner Project, Denise will organise a raffle to help Timor-Leste's extremely underweight children as 70 to 80% of babies are malnourished and to assist and educate mothers.

On the night all attendees wore a hat to celebrate **Hat Day**, a fund raising day where you wear a hat and make a donation to help shine a light on mental illness in Australia and raise awareness, 100% of the money raised for Hat Day goes to research into helping those affected by depression, anxiety, schizophrenia and many other illnesses.
