Guest Speaker Stuart Emslie, Nurse Unit Manager Clinical Services at Milton Hospital spoke on Leadership, Mentoring and Role Modelling, and the three main influences in his life. His father Rosco and mother Barbara were solid role models for him. His mother often saying: "Can't is Won't".



Stuart was taught, family first, respect for self and others. Tony Houghton, a Skip at Scouts (aka Skip), who had a chequered past, was another major influence in Stuart's life, giving him guidance and purpose. Bill Stevens (aka No.1), a leader at Venturers encouraged Stuart with his skills. Stuart recalled a three day camp at Blue Gum, in the Blue Mountains, where he gained problem solving and life skills. Stuart revealed that through these major influences in his life, it was the attitude and actions of his mentors that drove him.

Stuart mentioned two other influences in his life, Trevor Fisher, the manager at KFC, where Stuart was working, emphasised responsibility and trust and to stand up for what you believe in, as well as supporting each other. Peter Mangles (Alby) was another influence for Stuart and the best manager he has ever had. Peter was Stuart's boss in three different jobs and locations and led by example. Stuart went on to quote Harold S. Geneen; "Leadership is practiced not so much in words, as in attitude and in action".

Stuart thanked the members of the Rotary Club of Milton-Ulladulla for being influential people and role models within the community.
