Brian Morrison; 12 Nov Information Night for 35 princesses and their partners at the Civic Centre.

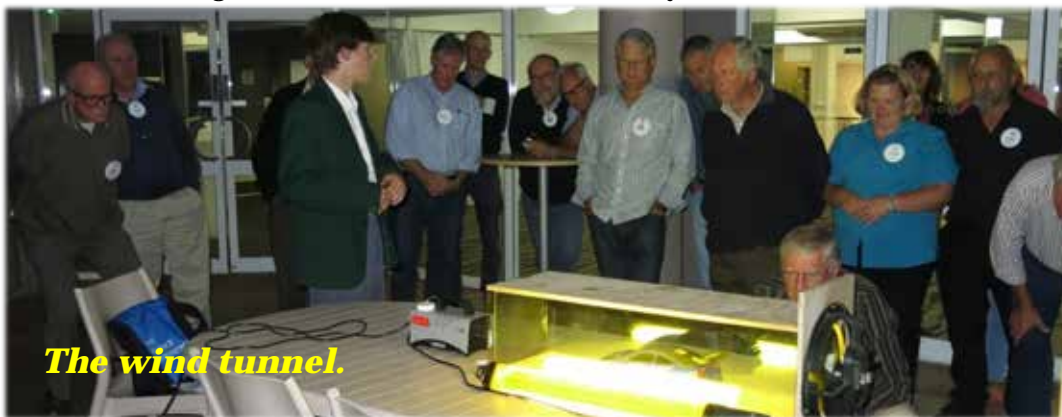
Bill Harris said that **Jacqui Thomson** broke a leg and is in hospital.

Guest Speakers Timothy Shoebridge and Patrick Faulconer;

Timothy Shoebridge, student at Ulladulla High School, was happy to speak of his recent visit and engaging experience, at the Australian National University - Science School Experience, sponsored by the Rotary Club of Milton-Ulladulla. The three day event provides an opportunity for aspiring science minded students to gain an insight into the actual work and technology behind the scenes, in the fields that they are most interested in. There were twenty students engaged in the program.

Timothy thanked Rotary for his amazing opportunity, before giving the club a live demonstration of aerodynamics in action, using his self-made wind tunnel with a toy car inside and a smoke machine.



Louise Allen of Milton Public School introduced Patrick Faulconer, one of her student's father, who had a dream and shared it with Louise. Louise and Patrick are now campaigning together to bring the dream of planting an Avenue Of Honour, in Milton, to replace the one that was originally planted in 1926 to honour the fallen Servicemen of Milton who fought in WW1.

Seventy six Camphor Laurel trees were planted along the highway near Stoney Hill, over the years, progress has largely eradicated these trees, with only five and a half still standing.

With the 100th anniversary of Anzac approaching, Patrick would like to honour these men and the locals who planted the memorial by creating a new Avenue Of Honour in Milton with as many as one hundred trees. Patrick said he would love to see the town come together as a community to achieve something of major significance.
