The members of the Ulladulla Men's Shed welcomed our members and prepared us an excellent meal. Drinks were provided by Jon Tucker and Leo Page from the Mollymook Fine Wines and Ales, food ingredients were supplied by Ulladulla Woolworths, while the members prepared the salads, the meat was cooked to perfection and served by the members and the delicious cakes were supplied by the Mollymook shopping centre's Bakery.

The Ulladulla Men's Shed is running out of space and Rotarians were shown the new extension, which has a DA approval, it will cater for a bigger membership and will provide more activities such as a computer training room, library, more space for social activities, board games, cooking lessons, increase office space, a glass house nursery, metal working, garden activities and a loading dock.
