Guest speakers, Dr Jessie Hoang and Dr Kevin Le from the Ulladulla Endoscopy and Medical Centre. They both arrived in Milton as training doctors in 2001 and were meant to stay for six months, but instead requested to stay for three years. In 2005 they both came back to Ulladulla and in 2008 they moved their practice to the highway, near the Ulladulla Plaza.

Drs Jessie Hoang and Kevin Le outlined some compelling statistics regarding bowel cancer and emphasised the importance of early detection, with screening from the age 50.

Bowel cancer is a disease predominantly seen in developed and affluent countries, with the highest rates occurring in Australia, New Zealand and Western Europe. In Australia bowel cancer is the second most common invasive cancer and is the second most common cause of cancer-related death after lung cancer, with a death every five hours from a road accidents, every four hours from breast cancer and every two hours from bowel cancer.
