Julia is studying at Achen University, starting her studies with 60 others, and continuing with about 30 fellow students at the largest teaching hospital in Europe. Her university training is highly technical and involves using "phantom patients" that looked like robots in dental chairs to me. Her training involves more technical dental practices than we do here in Australia.

Julia appreciates the assistance of Rotary in achieving her goals and is also looking forward to her next phase of her visit, visiting north Queensland.
