Phil Brown introduced our guest speaker author and ITC Security consultant **Roger Smith**.

Roger’s presentation on the security issues associated with the digital world was riveting and clearly explained the threats and risks associated with our everyday use of technologies connected to the internet; Leaving us with a broad understanding that what we and the other 3-4 billion users see of the internet is about 10% of what is happening on the “net”. Like an iceberg, it is not what we see, but what is “under the water” that we need to take care about. Roger re-assured us that it is OK and correct to be a little paranoid when we see unexpected but enticing emails that seem to contain a direct appeal, and not click-on the link but to delete them.

Roger’s take away message was for us to: 1 acknowledge that Cyber Security is “my problem”; 2 use passwords everywhere; 3 Update our software continually; 4 use a Firewall to protect our devices and never turn it off; 5 be paranoid- think before clicking.

Roger was provided us with one of his flyers that highlight the security issues that we need to keep in our mind when using phones and computers to access the internet. His flyer is attached to the Bulletin for your information.

When questioned; Roger suggested that FortiClient was, in his opinion, one of the best anti-virus and security application available for phones and PCs. Their website is <http://www.forticlient.com/#download>

His response to the question about shopping on-line, was if we do then use PayPal because of the security research PayPal are investing to stay ahead of the bad guys.

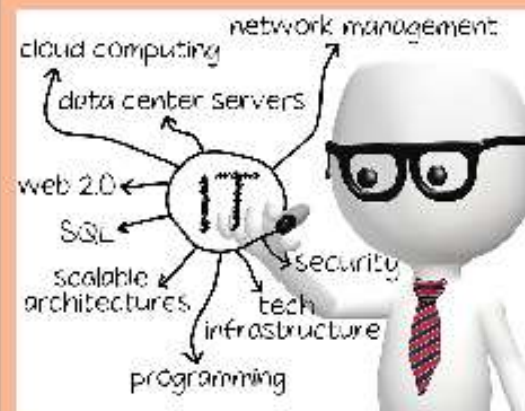
