Last weeks "meeting" was a combined event with about 90 people attending at the ExServos. Our Club combined with the Milton Ulladulla Business Chamber to host the evening. Representatives from local



Schools and businesses also attended. President **Clive Cross** and Milton Ulladulla Business Chamber President **Darren Sparks** MC'd the evening and introduced guest speaker; Christopher (Chris) Richards, an ANFF Technician at the Australian Research Council's Centre of Excellence in Electromaterials Science (ACES), based at the University of Wollongong. Chris gave an insightful presentation on the capabilities of the ACES Institute focusing on their research into 3D printing. Chris even set-up a live 3D printing demonstration for us to "understand" a little of the 3D printing technology being researched by Institute. I was amazed to see a fully functional 3D printed shifter (ie, a complex spanner) very similar to something that I was required to make, by hand, taking days, as a teenage apprentice fitter & turner.



You really had to be there to see what is being made possible through the worldwide research in 3D printing.
