from Milton hospital. Jo told us that the NSW health department nominated April as "Falls Prevention Month" creating an opportunity for community education on preventing falls. There is an information event in the Community Centre on May 11th at 10am. Jo's presentation was open and entertaining, giving us many timely reminders and anecdotes to highlight falls as a big issue, particularly for the elderly. Key to us taking positive action to prevent falls is keeping fit and vigilant.

Jo provided each of us with a NSW Health booklet "Staying active and on your feet" that identifies risk factors, prevention techniques, exercises, contact list and even a home safety checklist. If you missed the evening, grab a copy it takes 10 minutes to read and is an extremely informative document.
