Barbara gave us a brief history of the organization which commenced in 1988, to reach 4 homes today. Barbara also introduced Sue Mines, one of the many volunteers running Yurana. Yurana is Aboriginal for 'loving'. The homes are available to families with children suffering serious illness such as cancer or cystic fibrosis where a holiday on the coast might relieve some of the family's stress. Families are referred by social workers and health professionals.

For a number of years now Yurana volunteers have hosted a Christmas day luncheon at the Surf Club for members of the local community who may be spending Christmas day alone, as a means of saying thank you to the community.
