## International Report

Milton Ulladulla Rotarians provided financial support to both Shelter Box Australia, and Disaster Aid Australia, in the relief work carried out in Fiji, following Cyclone Winston. We continue to assist the Eyes For Africa program, where medical teams from Australia travel to Ethiopia to conduct eye surgery and conduct training for local doctors and nurses.

Donations were sent to the Rotary Foundation and Polio Plus (End Polio Now), supported by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation. We were fortunate to have sponsorship of the Arcadia Cinema in Ulladulla and 20th Century Fox, to stage the release of the film Eddie The Eagle. This proved to be a great fundraiser for the Polio Plus Foundation, while at the same time providing Rotarians, their partners and friends a great night out at the movies.

Rotarians Against Malaria (RAM) is another group assisted by our club. Funds donated provide necessities to assist in the prevention of malaria, such as protective nets which cost approximately \$10 per net. The funding target set by D9710 for 2015-16 is \$20,000 of which Milton Ulladulla donated \$1,200.

Other projects supported by our club during 2015-16 were Rotary Australia World Community Service (RAWCS), Rotary Oceania Medical Aid for Children (ROMAC), Interplast and Operation Cleft.

It has been a pleasure to support President Clive, during 2015-16. I hope my International, and variety of Toasts at club meetings have been of interest to members.
