5 minuter – Robin Cantrill: Spoke on going to Iceland with Jenny. Spoke the volcanic activity in Iceland, the thermal heated water you can swim in 50 degrees, greenhouse growing tropical fruits via heated water coming through the ground. Iceland was the first country to form Parliament. Robin found Iceland a truly fascinating country to visit.

Raffle was won by **Tony Fondacaro** who drew the 9 diamonds.

PP Dom Fondacaro spoke on the recent earthquake in Central Italy. Suggested to club members that maybe the Club could donate money to the clubs that have sponsored Giulia to come to Australia to help in the rebuild of towns effected by the earthquake.

PP Brian Morrison introduced **the guest speaker Barry Tomkinson** who spoke on National Parks Association – a volunteer community group. Focused in NSW, on activity in National Parks. NPA has over 20,000 paying members in NSW, there are over 1,000 bushwalks in NSW, assisting farmers and National Parks in keeping stock roots and bushwalks open to the public. The NPA also observe wild life and feral animal in their movements.

The NPA Ulladulla branch have easy walks on nearly every Wednesday and on Sunday's have the more difficult walks. The president of the Ulladulla Branch is 85 years young and their oldest member in 89 years young. The Ulladulla branch publishes a newsletter quarterly, do public lectures on environmental topics, and have social events every couple of months. Publish books on walks in the local area.

Though at the moment they are working a major project of the hidden gems in the local area, the NPA is trying to get SCC to adopt a proposal on bushwalking in the area to create awareness of bush walks in the Shoalhaven, so far they have the support of local MP', though needs more support from the public and community organisation. NPA Ulladulla branch is requesting assistance from Rotary to get involved with maintaining walking tracks.

"The machine has found a new home at one of the hospitals in Dili and to the best of my knowledge they had suitable qualified staff to operate such equipment.

Since we last contacted each other we have pushed on with various projects in East Timor, completing the "Meals on Heels" kitchen and providing a water supply to the clinic, hot and cold water to approx 10 outlets together with an electrical upgrade. We head off in October to put new trusses and roof on a school and electric lighting. Our next upcoming project is to build next to the kitchen and provide them with toilets, office, bulk store and a small activities - education room, we hope to start this early next year."
