Meeting Report; 29 August 2017, by Yvonne Young

President Phil Brown opened the meeting welcoming members and guests Sharon Rowen, Fern Wran, Ankie Hladio, Denise Fors, Deb Fondacaro, Rose Brown, Elaine Mathews, Beryl Wade, Steve Nicholas and Mario Puglisi the Guest Speaker.

As it was a social night there was no reports.

Guest Speaker Mario Puglisi spoke on the fishing and the fishing Co-op. Mario reminisced on the first time he spoke at Rotary Club of Milton-Ulladulla when the meetings were at the CWA Hall and Frank Bean was the president at the time, 1961-62.

Mario came to Australia in 1956 and settled in Ulladulla. After he left school started work at the co-op, in the early days observed its running then later became a director and still is a director to this current day.

Mario stated that it hasn't been easy in the fishing industry there has had problems including with the nets, when fishing inspector kept coming every day to measure the size of the nets and because of the type of netting used it kept on stretching. Mario and fisherman ending up taking the issue with the nets Minister of Primary Industry in Canberra got an audience with the Minister to state the issue with nets and its sizing, once the minister heard their issue changed the size of the nets.

Mario stated that there have been good years and bad years. For the Ulladulla Co-op the main income is the from Blue Fin Tuna, Mario explained the process of how the Blue Fin Tuna is exported straight away to Japan once it is caught. Mario spoke on finding ship wrecks, explain what a shot is in fishing terms and the different ways of fishing.
