Rotary and Gates Foundation Celebrate 10 Years of Working Together to End Polio Since 2013, the Gates Foundation has matched every \$1 Rotary commits to polio eradication 2-to-1.

### Current Status, as of 8 Dec 2017

Since 1988, we've seen a worldwide reduction in polio cases of 99.9%. Last year we only saw wild polio cases in 3 countries.
