**Meeting's Report; 19 June 2018**

**Vice President Trevor Schofield** opened the meeting in the absence of President Phil Brown welcoming members and guests Matt Potter NSW, Lincoln (YWCA), Zoe and Noah Smith, Yolanda and Warren Cozijn and Steve Hladio Jnr.

**International toast - John Goggins** toasted the Rotary Club of Alaska.

**Sectary John Payne** report - update on Tathra Bushfire from District, letter from a student at Ulladulla High School re trip to NASA later this year.

**Community Service Director Emile Jansen** is working towards a partnership with Ulladulla Men's Shed to assist with the build at Warden Head Lighthouse project. Emile is assisting the Mental Health working party with organising the project.

**Treasurer Ross Wade** reported on current year's donations and the outlined his proposal for re organising Club accounts to be clearer.

**Almoner Bill Harris** reported all Wednesday clients well. Maisie Bennett had been in Hospital, home now and going well.

**Lincoln Smith** from YWCA Nowra spoke on his youth frontiers project, within the Shoalhaven that is working with high schools of the area, including Ulladulla and Braidwood. Expecting to require 2hrs a week from beginning term 3 to end of term 4, Lincoln is seeking people to assist with the program as the participants would be volunteering in the community for the 2 hrs. With the program to be showcased in December. Youth participants could do fundraising projects of their choice, for example, growing a veggies garden or organising an event.

Volunteers are needed to mentor the youths running the projects. Mentors need to be over 18years. There would be training half day to be a mentor. Information night will be run at the high school.

**Guest Speaker Yolande Cozijn** spoke on Birds in the Backyard. Birdlife conservation groups in the area assist with research with National parks, maintaining bushland and reserves.

Yolande spoke about how land clearing for development is affecting the bird's homes. Interesting fact she provided was that the hollows in a gum tree take 150 years to develop.

Yolande show the members a number of slides about the different types of native birds that are found in our backyards. Yolande spoke on the best ways to create a habitat for birds. Which plants and foliage suit which birds best. Avoid using of chemicals and fertilizers. Using lawn clippings and leaf litter as mulch. Gardens can be neat or messy as you like.

Bird Baths are very effective in bringing birds into yards although they need to be out of reach for cats though and be under shelter from the sun and cleaned regularly.

Yolande outlined new findings relating to the "feed or not to feed" question, new thinking is that it is OK provided that the feeding station was kept clean and used quality foods that are suitable for the birds.

Key points plan, plant shrubs density, prune regularly and use different types of exotic and native shrubs.
