Ben Barry spoke on how he enjoys teaching in this area and has been teaching at Ulladulla High for 20 years. Ben teaches Society and Culture. Over the years, the Dept has raised money for Timor-Leste, students in that subject also assist residents of Sarah Clayton write their life stories, three students go to Kokoda each year, and students visit Vietnam every two years. This year 19 students went.

The focus of going to Vietnam was to explore self-resilience. The students raised money and donated \$2,000 and gave their old schools bags to the students of Vietnam. Students toured Hanoi City, Sapa, Haloing Bay, Hoi, walking tour, cooking classes, Eco tour, fly to Saigon and Cu Chi Tunnel, students visited an orphanage and played games with the children at the orphanage. We are hoping the students will be able to attend the Club at a later date and speak on their views of the Vietnam trip.
