**Guest Speaker Vicki MacDougall** spoke on texting while driving, after the death of her daughter Brooke. Brooke was 20 years old when she was killed instantly while the car Brooke was driving hit a tree, travelling at about 100km per hour. Vicki and her family formed a foundation called "Brooke Richardson dont-txt-n-drive Foundation" about week after the accident to increase the awareness of the danger of texting while driving.

Vicki showed members a short presentation of Brooke's life. Vicki spoke on how their lives have changed after the passing of Brooke. Vicki spoke on the change in law in Victoria the change has made it illegal for

P platers to touch a phone while driving, this law is called "Brooke's Law" is named after Brooke.

Vicki then spoke on the different forums the family has attended, making a change little by little. Vicki isn't against people having a mobile phone, it's just using them in a car in particular while driving. Vicki and her husband Andrew have travelled to Ulladulla to speak to the students at Ulladulla High School who are participating in the Driver Education Program.

Chairperson Bill McInnes then spoke on the Driver Education program and how it has assisted students with better understanding of driving and awareness of roads and conditions. Bill thanked PP Phil Brown in assisting with the insurance of the Driver Education program under Rotary's Insurance, Bill then went on to thank Rotary for their assistance with the Driver Education program over the past 29 years.
