Meeting 10 November 2020

Meeting opened by President Leonie welcoming members and guest Sarah Date.

Rotary toast given by PP Ross Wade, International Director Grant Schultz gave the international Lithuania followed by Argentina for beating the 'All Blacks' on the weekend in Rugby Union.

Secretary report PP Dale Wilford informed members of various items in the mail box including an invitation to attend the accidental Counsellor and a thank you card from Disaster Aid Australia.

Dale spoke on the Special meeting to be held on Monday 7th December at 6.00pm via zoom at regarding the winding down of District 9710.

Community service Director Yvonne Young presented the "ringmaster" Ian Tibbles his hat for the painting at Mullala, Ian then went through the plan for the weekend. Community BBQ on Sunday 13th December at Rotary Park Rotarian Emile Jansen spoke on the planning for the Community BBQ with a treasure hunt, Santa from Caringbah Rotary Club and elves from our club. Emile spoke on kids' games being organized including building a snowman/sandman just to name a few. Though assistance is needed with hiding the treats for the treasure hunt, and Santa grotto. Emile said information would be emailed to members regarding the assistance needed on the day.

Youth Director Avril Pryor informed members of a zoom meeting for the NYSF which was held on the weekend. NYSF is going to be on line and only spending 3 days at the university during this event. This is the only program going ahead at the current time due to COVID-19.

Guest speaker Sarah Date from Safe Waters refuge in Ulladulla spoke on the shelter and how it operates. It is operated by 6 committee members and 40 volunteers, primarily providing safe shelter, have a meal, connect people, shower facilities, laundry facilities available shared bedrooms, for people who are escaping from Domestic Violence (DV) or who have become homeless.

Sarah spoke on the 3 projects firstly being the shelter, then in the future looking at DV counselling and a Detoxes Centre in the area, though just focusing on the Shelter at the moment.

Sarah then informed members that there are 2 volunteers on duty each night at the shelter. The shelter has been opened for two weeks, there is a mentor program and if they stay more than a week its \$15 a night. A home has been donated by Ground Swell Church which is to be renovated over the next year.

The current shelter is in South Street the rent for the premises for the next year is being paid for by the local church organizations

PP Michael Mastronardi spoke on the Driver education program, the program is still being organized though it is day by day looking at February 2021 for the program to operate.

PP Phil Brown spoke on the Lighthouse project which is now up for public consultation there are 3 options, Phil is going to send around to members for comment.
