**Guest Speakers Tracy and Jo from Ulladulla SES Unit**, spoke on a year that was with the 2019/20 Fire season where the SES assisted for 67 days of the Currowan fires, then responding to over 600 call outs during 2020.

During COVID trained 22 new members during COVID. Ulladulla SES finished their service for the fires on the 4/2/20 than responded to the first flood on 9/2/20. Tracy informed members of the PAD program where SES members have been trained to use a defib, which enables members to respond to emergencies, Tracy explain the stages they go through with PAD.

Working alongside of NSW Ambulance to respond to emergencies where the Ambulance could be delayed and then the Ulladulla SES members can respond to that emergency in getting to the scene before the Ambulance and assisted in saving a life than handing over to the NSW Ambulance officers as required. Tracy thanked the club members for their assistance during 2020.

SES is looking to have a spreadsheet of the locations of the defib in our area, and to find out who is maintaining them, SES are looking for help from our Club.

Tracy encouraged members to down load app called Emergency Plus, works even if you don't have reception on your phone. This app will give your exact location.

Beck Cameron thanked the guest speakers.
