Guest Speakers from the 477 Ulladulla Fire Brigade were introduced by Leonie Corrin-Smith. **Mitch Butt** and **Tony Bewley**. Mitch is very new to the brigade. He previously owned Bakers Delight and decided he needed a change. He now also works as an electrician as well as being a member for the brigade.

They are asking the club to help in the way of a donation of specialised night lights. These lights are extremely important when it comes to attending accidents at night. It was until we had a truck accident that they realised how important these lights would be. Also, every fire fighter needs an individual head torch. They are only supplied and a few, and there isn't enough to go around. So maybe some extra funding would be good to obtain these for each member of the brigade.

There are 18 firefighter and 2 trucks that service an area from Termeil to Sussex Inlet turn off.

They work alongside our RFS. They also specialise in cliff rescues. It is estimated that 2 sets of lights would amount to \$1500.00. A small price to pay for such a valued resource in our local area.
