5 October 2021 Zoom meeting;

President Tony Fondacaro welcomed members and guest speaker Meredith Jaffe from StoryFest committee.

International toast was to all the Rotary Clubs of Tasmania for their response to the COVID-19 situation in assisting the Tasmanian Health Dept with man power, toast given by new **International Director John Payne**.

Guest Speaker Meredith Jaffe thanked members for the Club involvement in the festival not only for sponsoring the schools' events, also volunteering throughout the event. Meredith spoke on the StoryFest weekend held in June 2021, Meredith informed members of how the festival was held on the weekend between the two lockdowns. Meredith spoken on how this year's festival had increased tickets sales, book sales, also participation from both schools and preschools in the area all areas saw increases from the last festival in 2019. Meredith stated that the committee had made the decision to hold the festival biannually instead of yearly, mainly due to workload to organise the festival.

The festival is held during cooler part of the year this assists local businesses to attract tourist during the quiet part of the year. Part of the StoryFest program is encouraging local musicians and school students to perform at the festival the committee is looking at increasing these areas of the program for the next festival in 2023. Meredith stated she is working with the High Schools to recognise the volunteering of the students for StoryFest, the volunteering going towards Events course for Year 12 students. In the exit surveys the committee found that people were mainly from the local area though quite a few come from area including





Canberra, Newcastle, Victoria and Sydney. The StoryFest is a great way of promoting the local area, during the winter months. Meredith informed members of the involvement of ABC Illawarra and ABC South who broadcast from the event this year and are keen to continue the broadcasting for future festivals, the committee are looking at regional newspapers for publishing the program.

Meredith is hoping to continue the sponsorship including NSW Tourism funding. The committee were overwhelmed by the fantastic reviews received not only by audiences but by the artists as well.

President Tony informed members that **Christine Bell** has stepped down as International Director, and **John Payne** has agreed to step up as the International Director, *thank you John*.

Community Service PP Phil Brown thanked members for assisting in the moving of 130 bollards to the new storge container, in particular **Simon Brown** for building a cage for the bollards to be stored in and Albos Traffic Management for donating bollards for the Blessing of the Fleet festival.

International Director Christine Bell informed members that the money for the ShelterBox for the Haiti earthquake has been sent.

Almoner Bill Harris informed members PP Tim Gregory is going well, Maisie Bennett is well and no change with PP Keith Bennett.

PP Leonie Corrin-Smith reported on the Blessing of the Fleet Princess Ball is being planned for the 18th December, also the donation for the SESCA (Shoalhaven Emergency Services Community Awards) of \$750.00 PP Leonie asking members to come up with a organisation where the money could go.
