Past Treasurer Report: PP Ross Wade spoke on the Community Chest Programme initiated by our Club last year. The Community Chest operates out of the Ulladulla Resource Centre. He advised where the funds have been spent thus far. He then spoke on the statistics regarding suicide intervention from the Ulladulla Resource Centre.

Separately, Ross also advised that \$7,500 for fire focused support had gone to 100 people.
