Vice President John Hozack chaired the meeting and welcomed all, specially Adam Clear, brother Jacob and their parents Sharon and Darren Clear. 16 members and 4 guests were in attendance.

Geoff Johns said thanked the helpers with Bunnings' BBQ which raised \$723 and passed around the roster for the long weekend Sat 10 June 2023.

Guest Speakers, **Adan Clear** helped by his brother **Jacob** addressed the meeting. Adam has been a student of the Ulladulla Primary school, and now attends year 11 at the Ulladulla High School and is MUCK's founder. Jacob is a student at ANU.

He came up with the idea of MUCK Up, Milton Ulladulla Community Kindness, an anti-bullying movement when he was in year 8; to have a diversity club and a safe place for students, they have around 20 students attending regular meetings.

Their first event, helped by Matt Dell, 'Do it for Dolly Day', an event named after Amy Jayne (Dolly) Everett, who was a 14-year-old Australian teenager who died by suicide after extensive cyberbullying.

The next MUCK event a Master Chef event set for Sunday 2nd of July at the Ulladulla Civic Centre and will feature groups of four youths teaming up with some of the area's top local chefs to compete in a Master Chef style challenge.

An event which will send messages of kindness and education around bullying to local kids and their parents. Another idea is to do a mural of a painted butterfly to spread the word of kindness and their long-term goal is to make Ulladulla a kind town.
