The café is open Monday to Friday, some of food is donated by Ulladulla Woolworths and Bawley IGA, they also supply meals to Safe Waters, foster families, some of the operating money needed is donated by generous community people and from the sale of uniforms, in shop 8 Eastside Mall, Milton Ulladulla School Uniforms.

They also provide mental health checks and provide employment opportunities and education through training of people with disabilities, as well as take them to discos, Luna Park, Easter Show, bowling, watch movies, amongst the activities they offer.
